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- x Chaperones are expected to be familiar with the Student Code of Conduct and school and divisional discipline policies and shall report all suspected violations to the trip supervisor immediately.
- x Chaperones may not discipline a student, staff member or another chaperone. Consequences for inappropriate behavior will be determined by the trip supervisor.
- x Drinking of alcoholic beverages by a chaperone at any time during the trip is prohibited.
- x Smoking by a chaperone at any time during the trip is prohibited.
- x Chaperones must actively supervise and maintain an accurate check of members assigned to them.
- x Overnight chaperones may not retire until all students are in their rooms, all visiting between rooms has ceased, and chaerones have verified the safety and security of the students.
- x Chaperones will not have free time for independent sightseeing, tours, or shopping.
- x Gender of the group members shall be considered when assigning chaperones and floor assignments.
- x Chaperoneswill not be permitted to bring siblings of participating students or other persons on a field trip.
- x Parents or student relatives who are not chaperones or student participants in the trip will not be permitted to interfere with the chaperones responsibilities, unless approved by the trip supervisor.
- x Chaperones must wear appropriate clothing at all times.
- x Medical release waivers for each student shall be carried on all field trips. In case of an accident, the medical release waivers shall be presented to the treating physician. A student's permission slip shall be attached to the student injury incident report which is required with an accident.
- x Chaperones are required to report any illness of students to the trip supervisor immediately.
- x For the welfare of the chaperone, he/she should be in good physical health. Chaperones should expect extensive walking daily, on uneven terralinus travel through winding mountainous roads, and exposure to culturally different environments
